Due to growth in the business, Shawview Consulting is seeking a health economics and policy research consultant to support the delivery of Australian and global consulting projects to clients in the areas of health policy, pharmaceutical pricing policy and health economics. The position will work closely with the Principal and Shawview Consulting project teams in researching and writing research reports and policy positions, analysing economic and market information on the health market, preparing communication materials, conduct research activities and business development.

This is a part-time position initially working for 2.5 days per week for an initial 6-month contract. The position can be based remotely where the person can work from anywhere with flexible work hours. However, preferably the person should be available to participate in Australian project work during Australian office hours. The main issue is to ensure delivery of good quality outputs to deadlines. The role would suit someone familiar with the health, pharmaceutical, life science and medical device sectors and experience in, or good knowledge of pharmaceutical pricing policy, the life sciences industry, global health issues and health economic policies, particularly with experience in Australia.

Roles and responsibilities

- Support the project consulting work of Shawview Consulting, as directed by the employer
- Conduct policy, economic, business and legislative research on issues including pharmaceutical and medical devices policy, pricing policy, health economics and HTA, life sciences, public policy, economics, innovation, global health policy and other such issues
- Draft substantive policy documents, research papers, key message documents, presentations and other such materials as directed by the employer
- The work will have a focus on both Australian and international policy and market trends relevant to Australia, but may also support Shawview Consulting's global health practice
- Support the Principal in external advocacy to the extent the scope of the position allows
- Attend meetings, represent Shawview Consulting, take minutes, develop action plans, strategy documents, engagement plans and the like
- Support the Principal in developing standard business processes, corporate policies and other systems for Shawview Consulting
- Some administrative support work for some projects, including organising meetings and interviews, and
- Other activities agreed with the Principal.
